
The Business Club started the 1969-70 year as though it was going places.

Sophomore Ed Machinski, running his first full year of competition, knocked minutes off his during four successive meets, closing finally with a 33:18. Tony Communiello, a soph, and freshman Tom Funke are two teammates who add to the sharp competitive spirit of the team. In this meet, Serrao placed 6th with 23:47, 45 seconds off the 4.3 mile course record, and Driscoll ran 24:01 for 10th place.
