The building which houses the McGarry Library served as the corporate headquarters of the Brooklyn Union Gas Company during the 19th century.

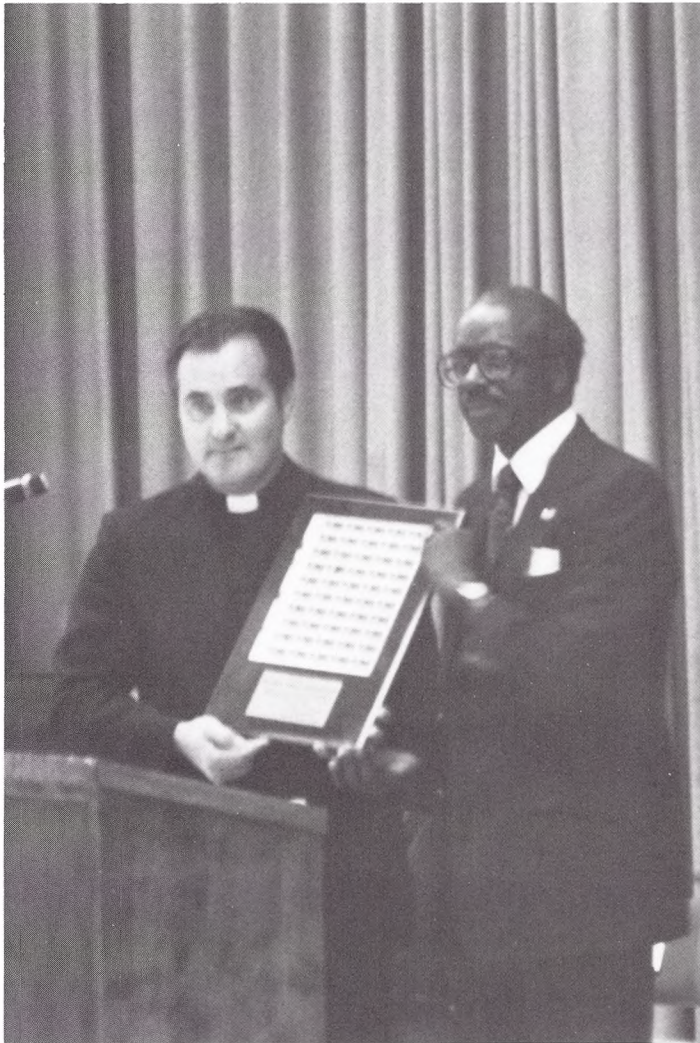
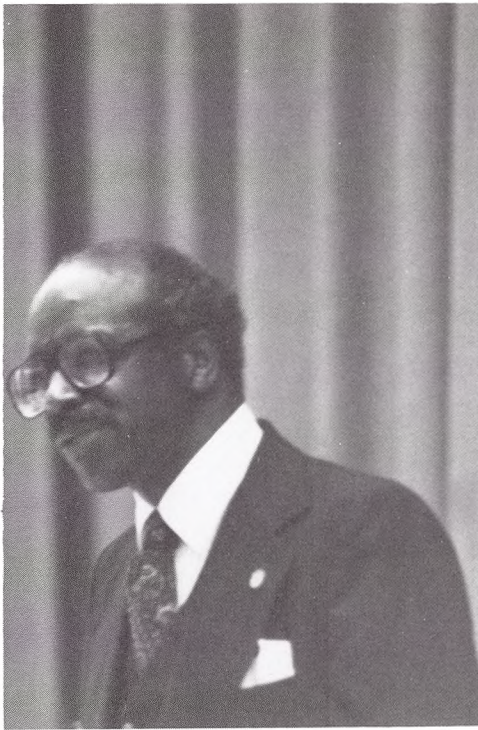

Ending the ceremony was a benediction given by the Reverend Michael A. Cerrano, President of the Alumni Association. After which the guests were moved to Founder Hall study area for a "Gala" wine and cheese reception. Immediately outside of Founders' Hall in the front of the College was a Mobile Post Office Van out of which the St. Francis Stamp was being sold. Also in the College Relations Office a commemorative first day cover was being sold for a dollar each. The reception broke up around five o'clock.

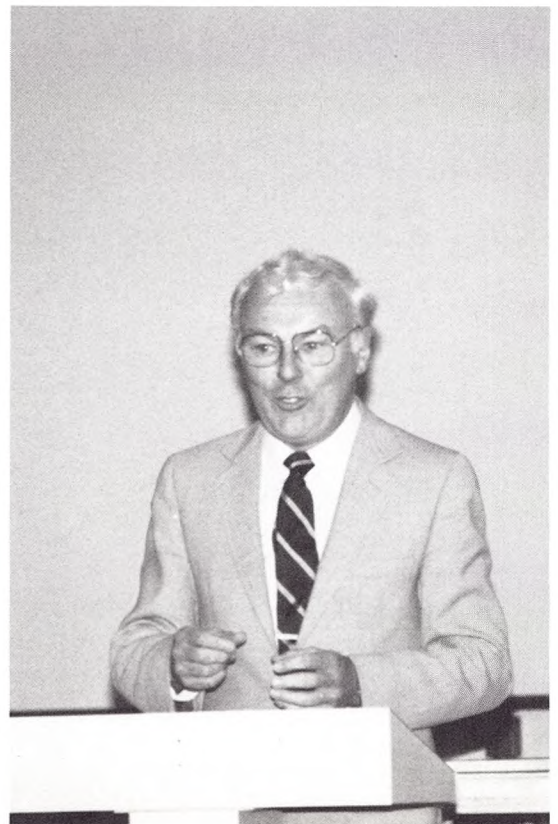
All involved in the ceremony seemed to enjoy themselves and the invited guests seemed to find the day very festive and informative.

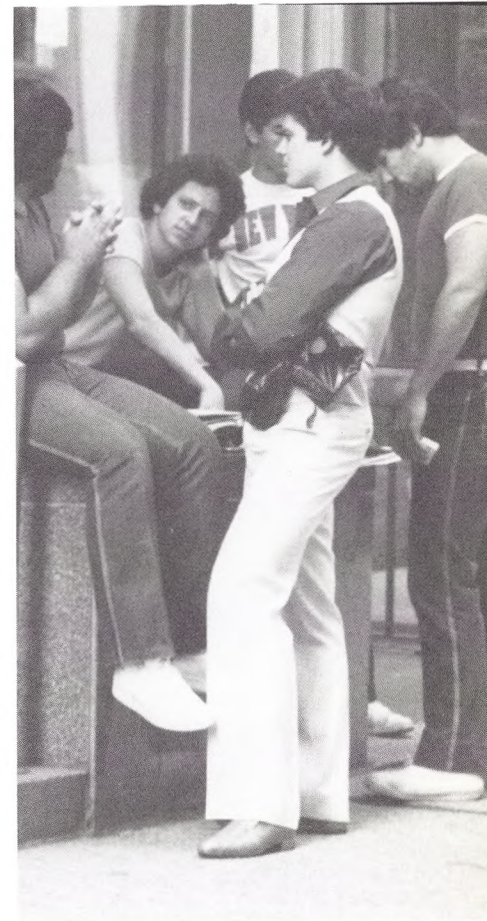
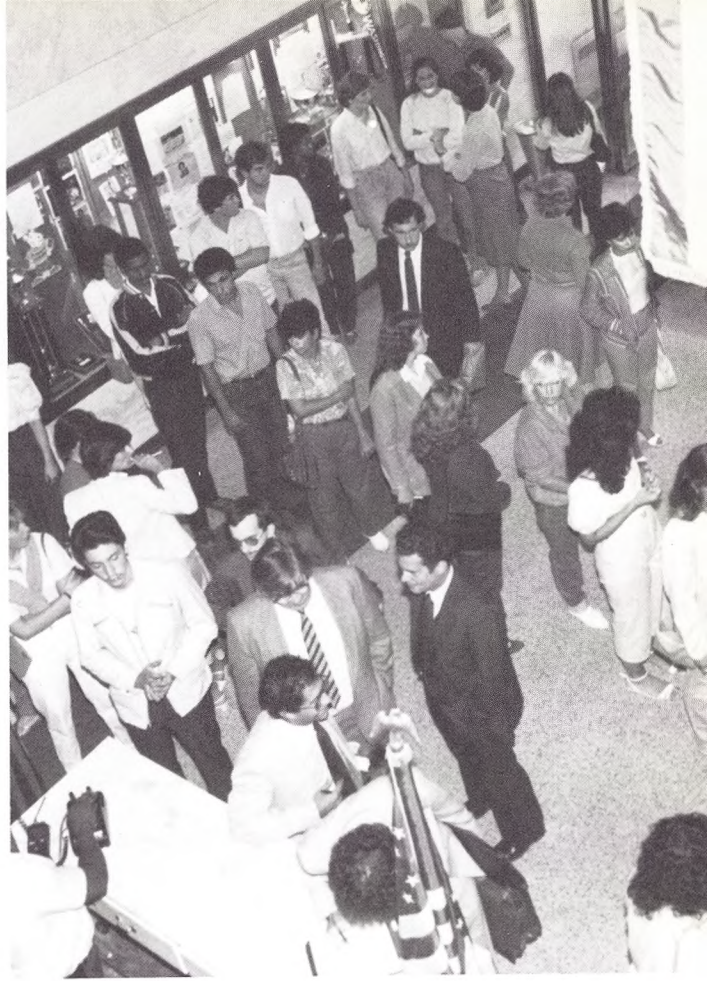
