


STUDENT GOVERNMENT










XI EPSILON OMEGA


The building which houses the McGarry Library served as the corporate headquarters of the Brooklyn Union Gas Company during the 19th century.























ST. FRANCIS STAMP CEREMONY OCTOBER 8, 1982

Bro. Donald introduced Reverend James A. Gardiner, S.A. who is the Chairperson of the Executive Committee on the 800th Anniversary of the Birth of St. Francis. 

All involved in the ceremony seemed to enjoy themselves and the invited guests seemed to find the day very festive and informative.






