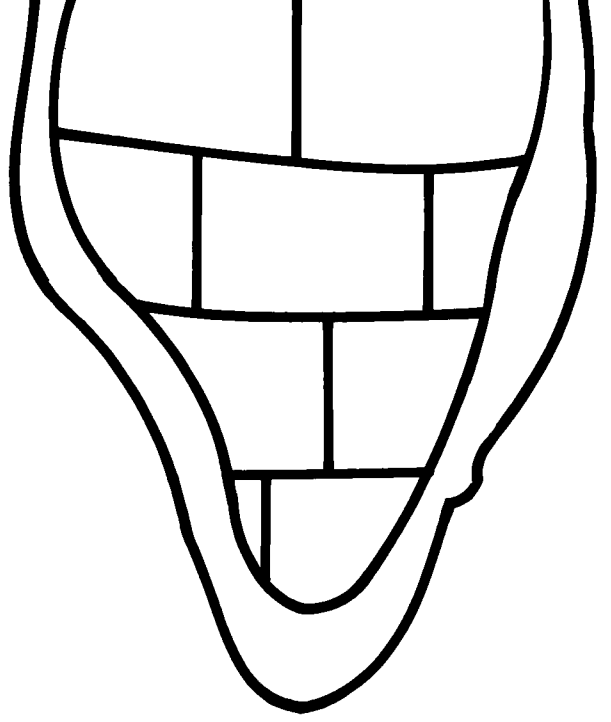




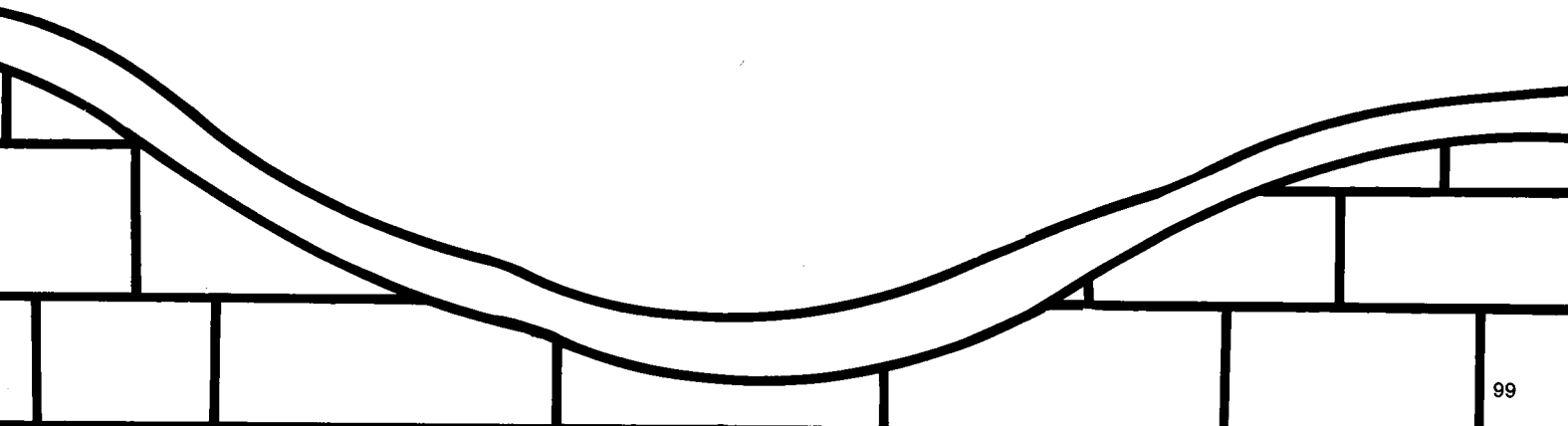
STUDENT GOVERNMENT

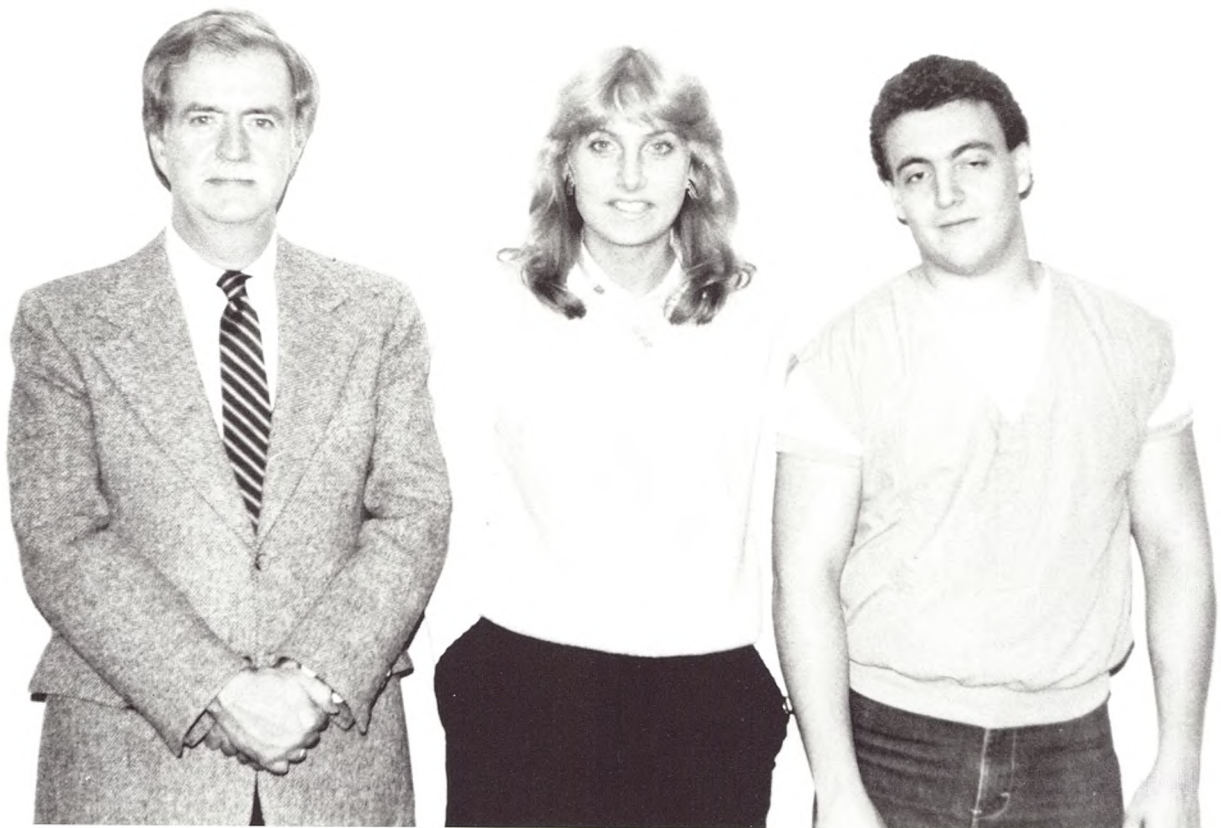


DUN SCOTUS HONOR SOCIETY
