
The Voice is the genuine word of St. Francis College. It is our own college paper, written by the students, for the students and college community. It explores the news, events, arts and beliefs of the St.

Francis community. All involved with The Voice are dedicated to upholding the excellent quality of journalism which has been associated with this paper from the beginning.










#### That's all Folks
