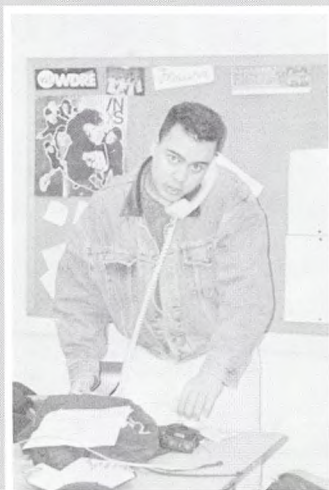
The Voice is the genuine word of St. Francis College. It is our own college paper, written by the students, for the students and college community. It explores the news, events, arts and beliefs of the St.

Career Placement helps students find jobs while in school and after graduation.

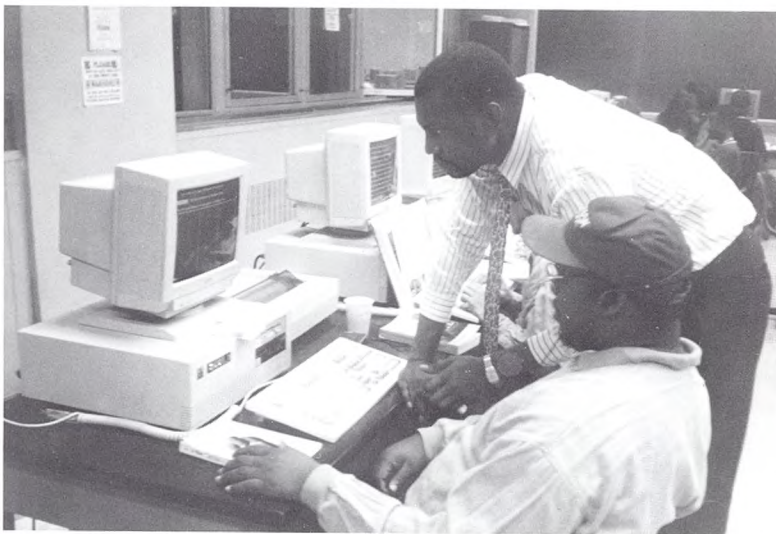
