John O'Connor and Mary Pergola played a married couple, both contemplating death. The characters were Tom and Hope Ames.



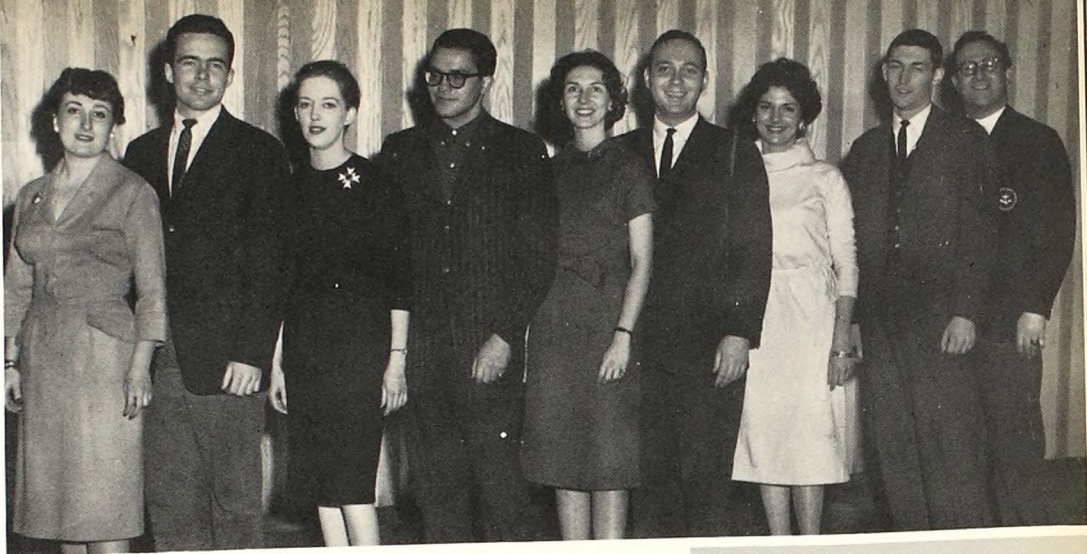
