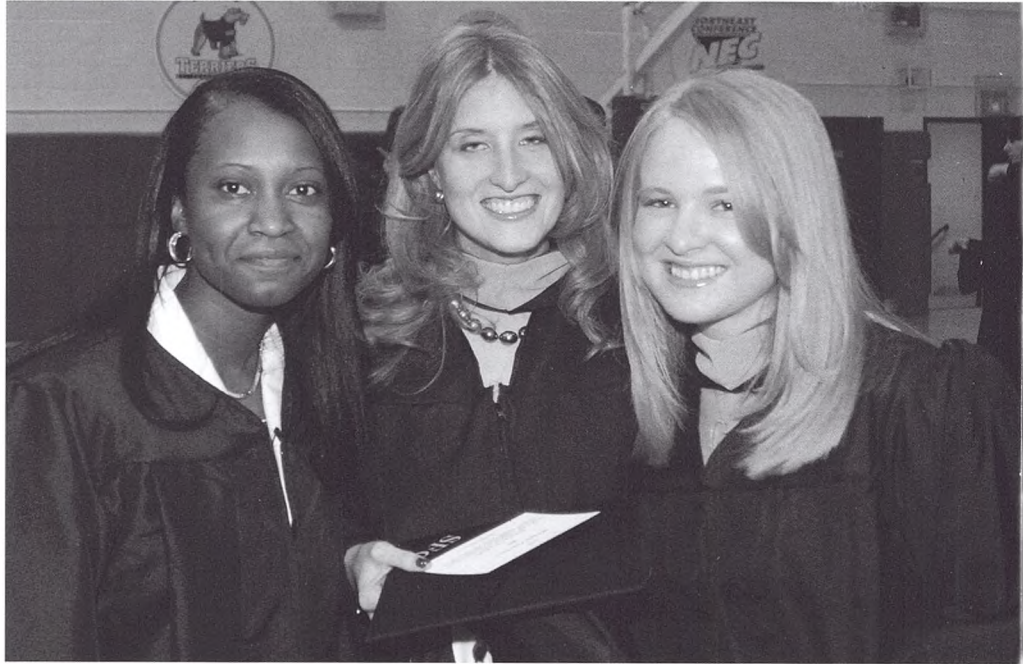


Baccalaureate

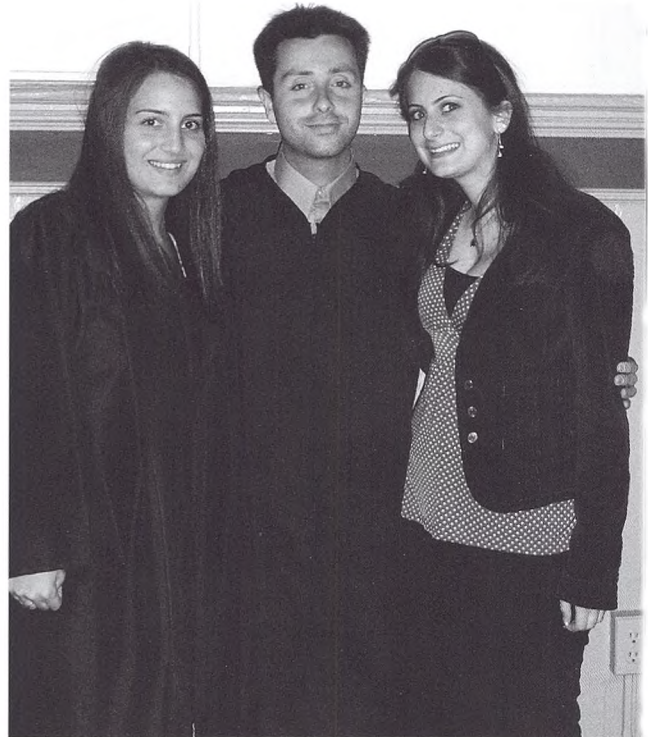
