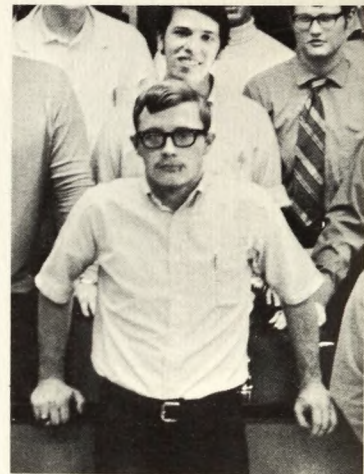
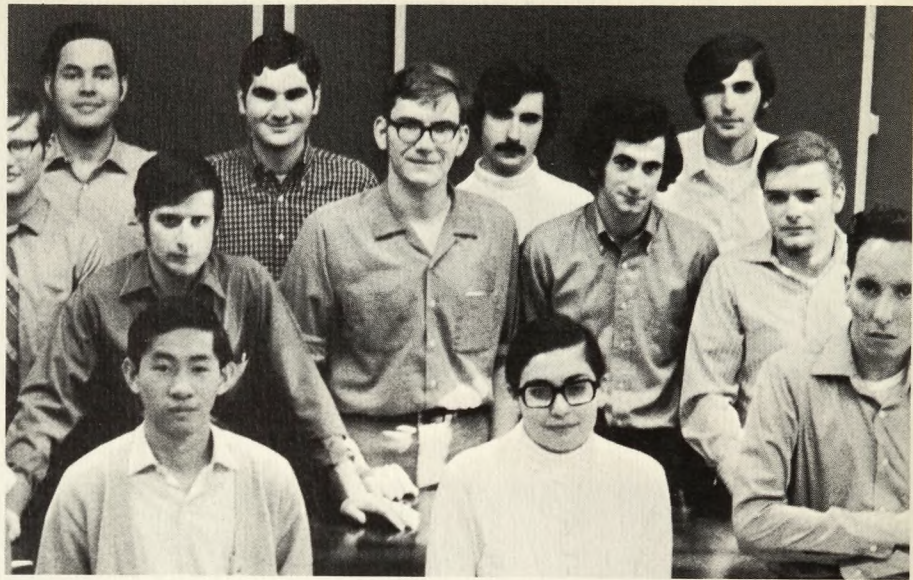


Science Society
