
Among the year's achievements were an inspiring rendition of hymns at the Christmas Assembly, and a recital during the ceremonies dedicating the student recreation area.

The group also appeared before many civic groups and clubs, where their presentations were warmly received.






Professor Fiorenza, Moderator and Conductor.


