


In the past year St. Francis students have seen one antiquated building imploded and the steel superstructure of a state of the art Academic Enhancement Center erected. The new Academic Enhancement Center will include fourteen smart classrooms that include wireless internet access and new multimedia equipment, a new library which will include features for greater enhancement for research and study purposes, a new ninety seat theatrical/lecture hall that will facilitate lecture and seminars for classes as well as extracurricular activities and new student lounges.







The new Academic Enhancement Center is due to be completed in November 2005; the structural framework is already completed. On the morning of December 8th St. Francis administrators, faculty and students signed the tallest beam in the new Enhancement Center. The new building will be constructed

mostly out of recycled materials and will make the most of natural light. Students look forward to having

access to a modern library and the new opportunities that the building provides to further their education.
