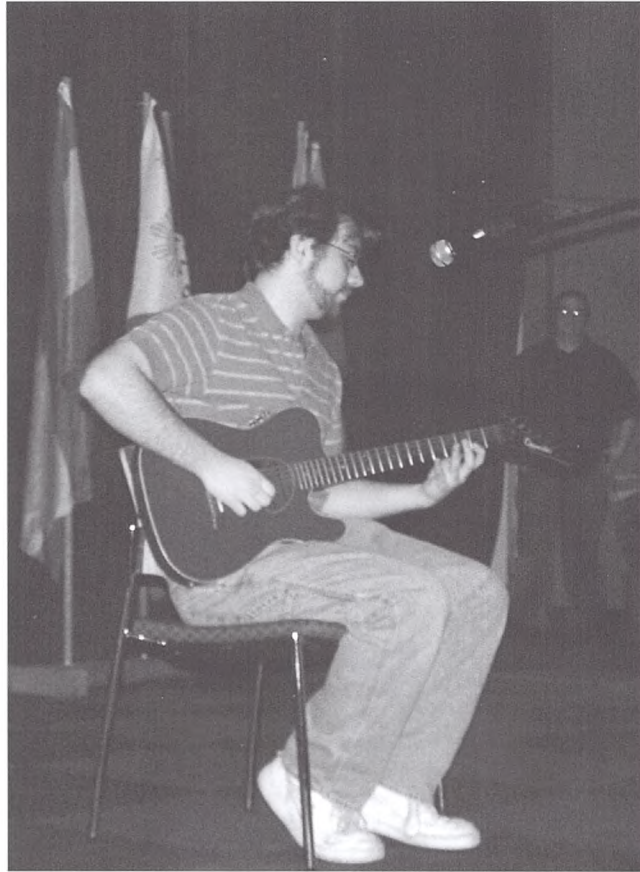


Community Day

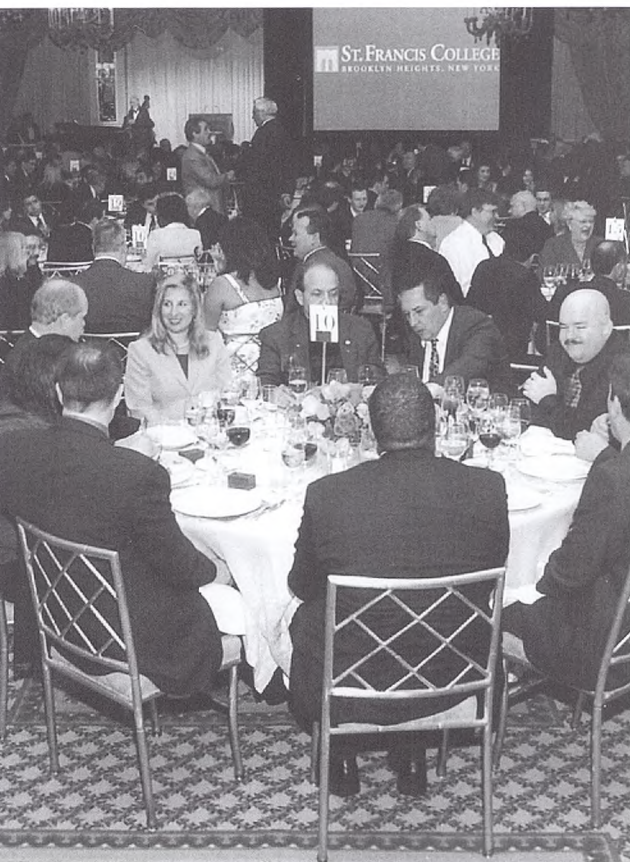


Charter Dinner
