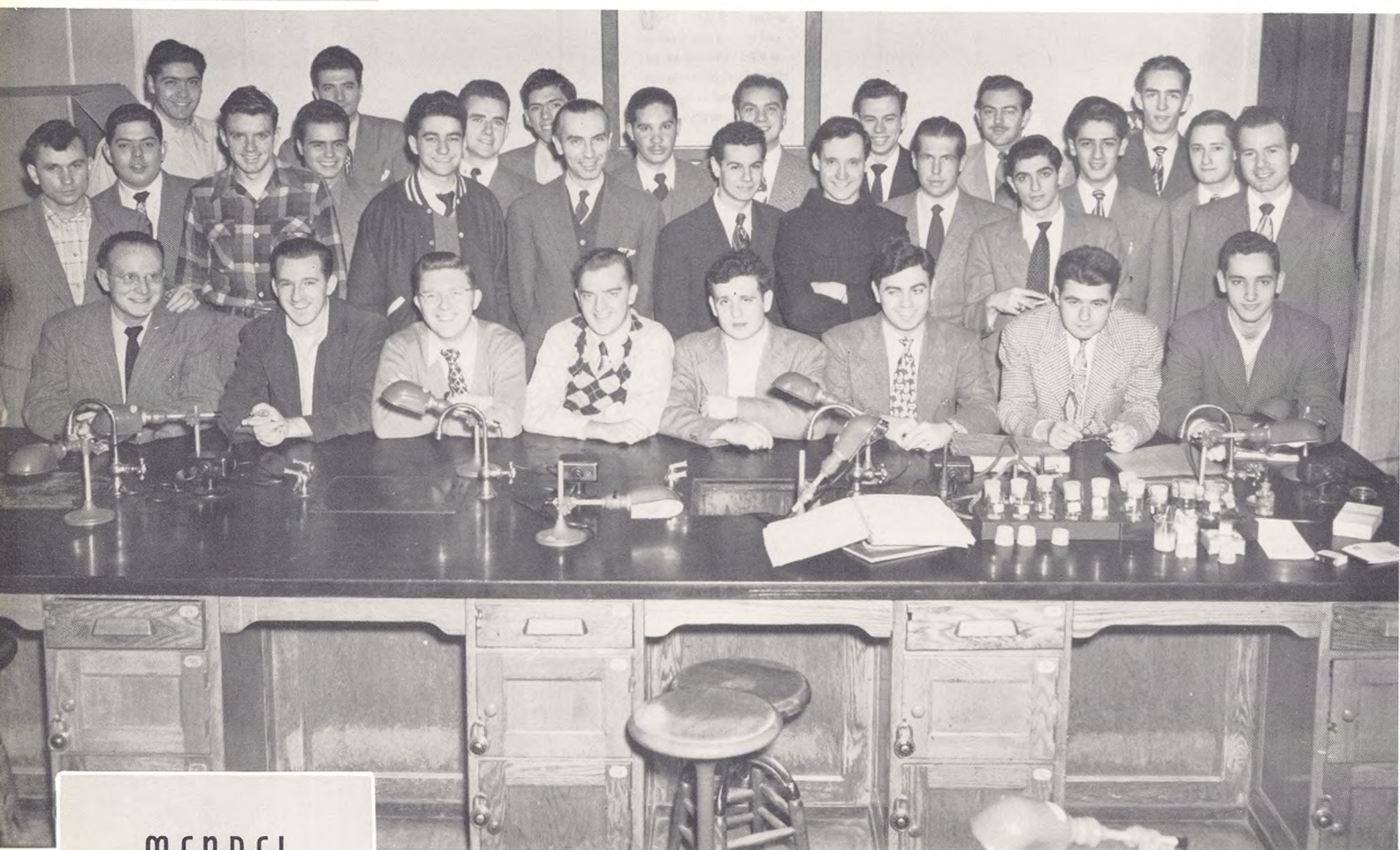




INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS CLUB
