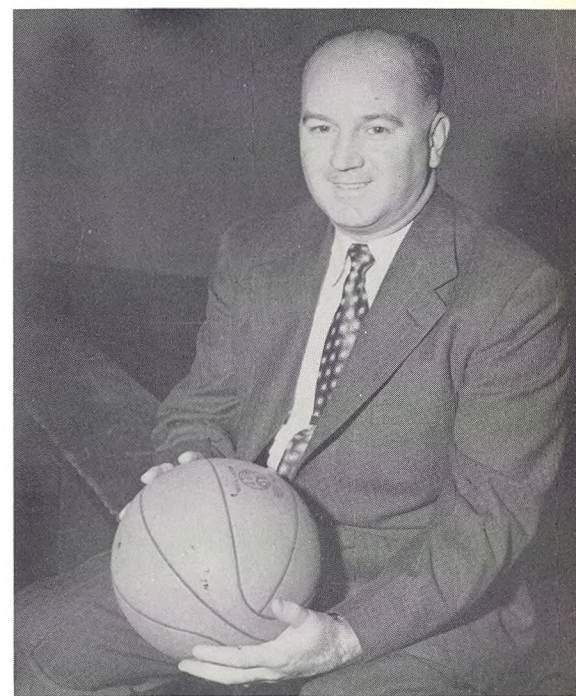
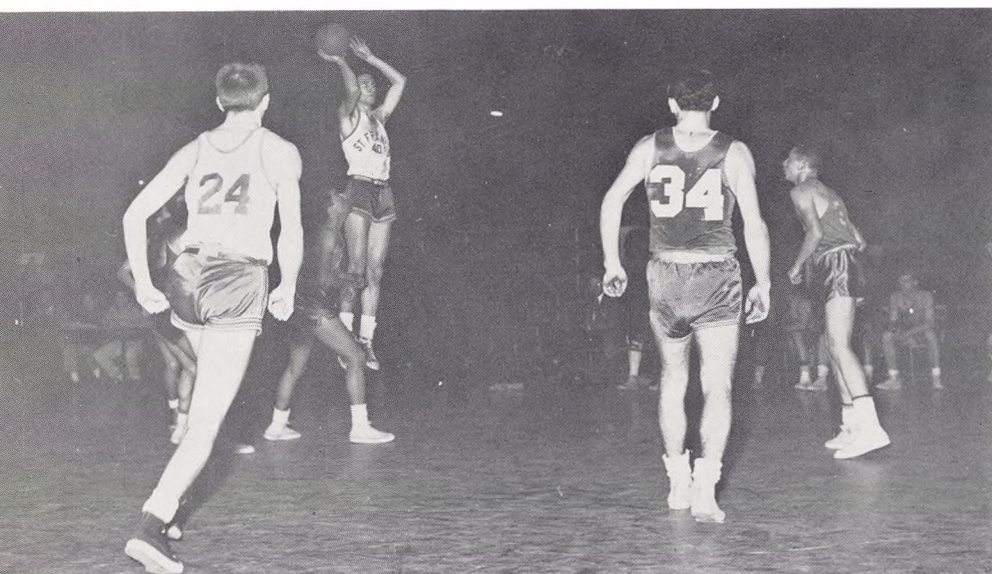
TURN OF THE CENTURY
