Star of the Sea, Inc. was founded in 1979 by a young nun, Sr. Angeline, who was deeply moved by the plight of homeless women whom she saw sleeping against the cold, gray walls of Penn Station.

Sr. Angeline began the task of making a home for the penniless, the hungry, the forgotten women of New York and in 1980, Star of the Sea became a reality. Star of the Sea is not subsidized through the Church, the City or the State. While Star of the Sea will take any monies that government will give it towards the rehabilitation of abandoned housing stock, its co-directors in keeping with the concept established by Sr. Angeline back in 1979 accept only donations from private groups and individuals who wish to give in a personal and loving way. Star of the Sea must be doing something right because in 1992, the doors are still open, the rooms are still filled and a little shelter on South Rd. in Jamaica, Queens, is considered to be a true beacon of light not only to the homeless but also to the community and the neighborhood which it serves.
