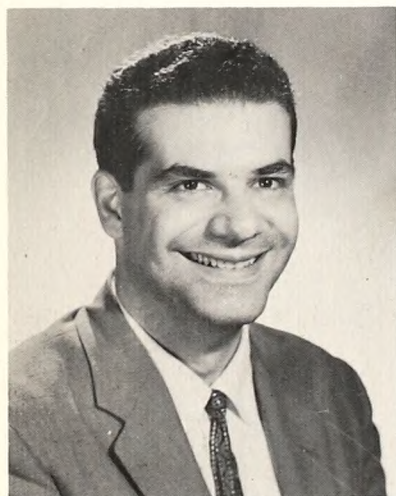


**FRANCIS ANG**

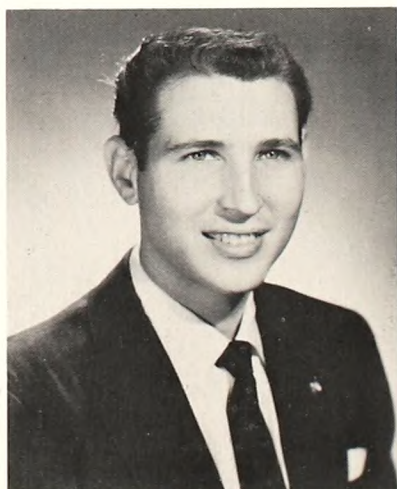
