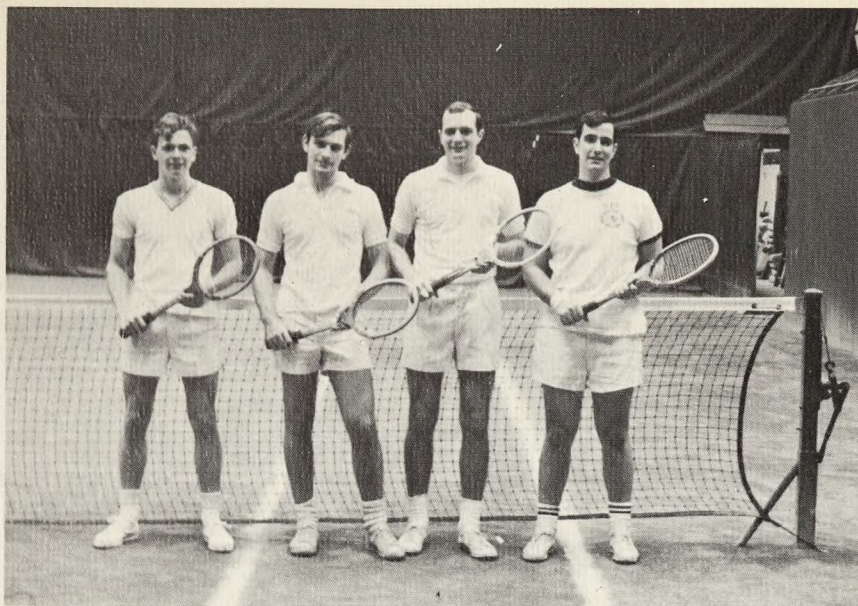


T E N N I S
