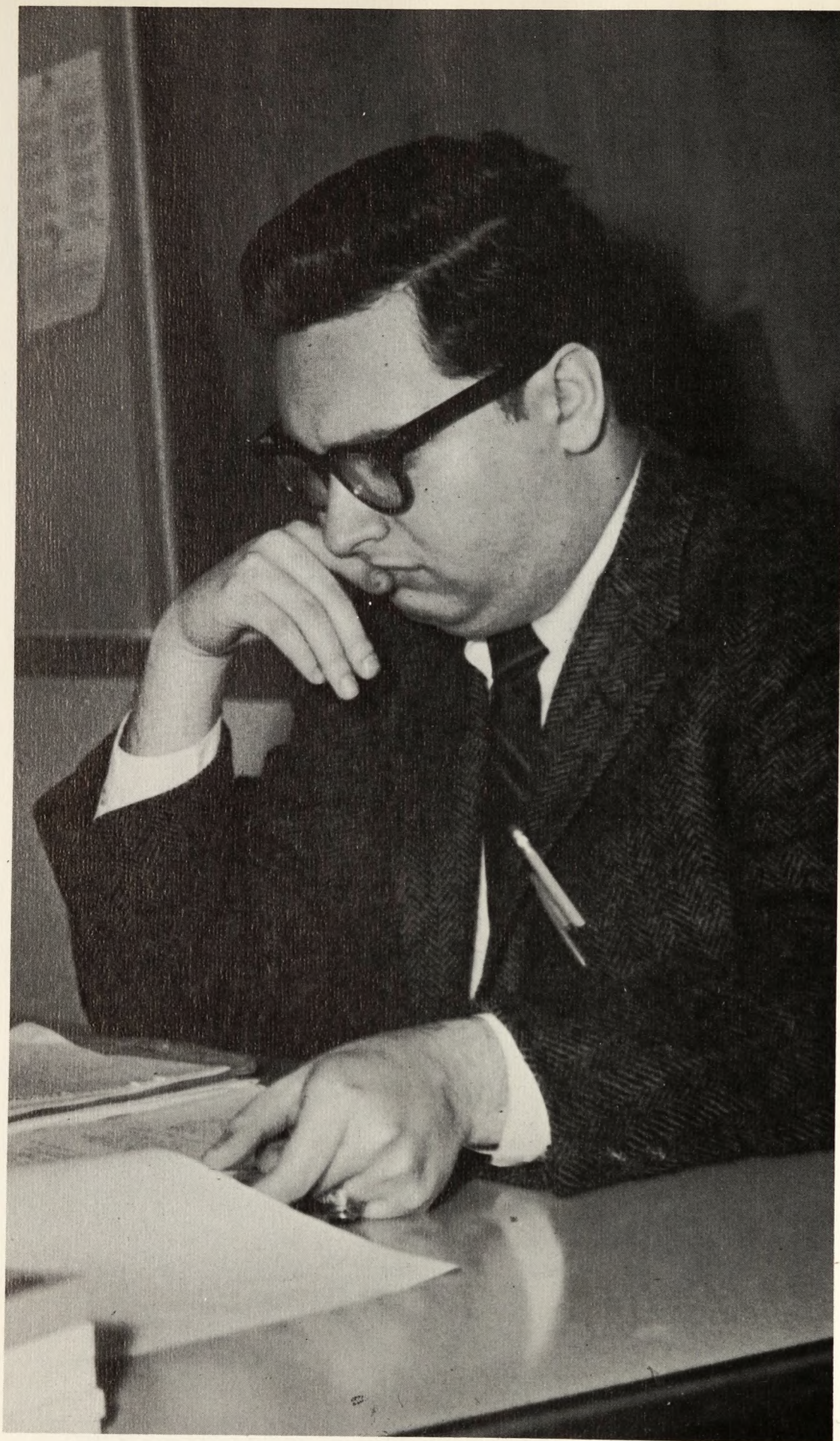




Tom Raftery, Voice Editor-in-Chief, completes another by-line.
