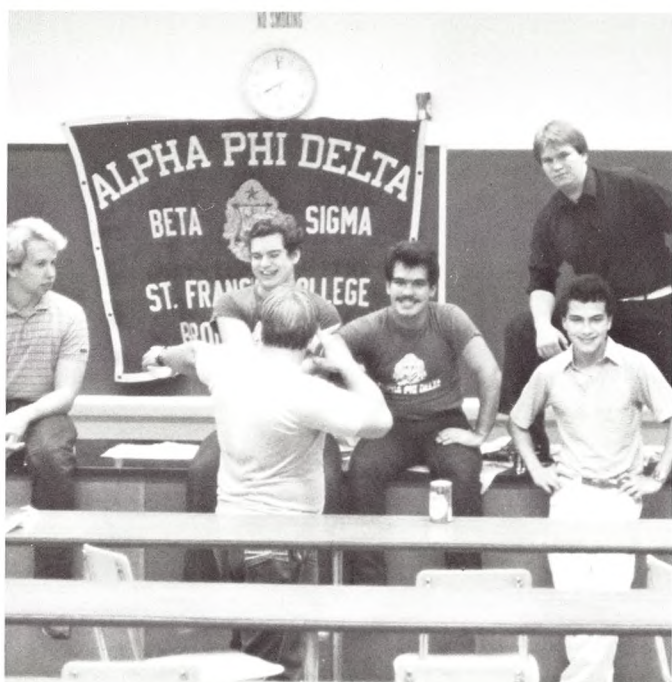


ALPHA PHI DELTA
