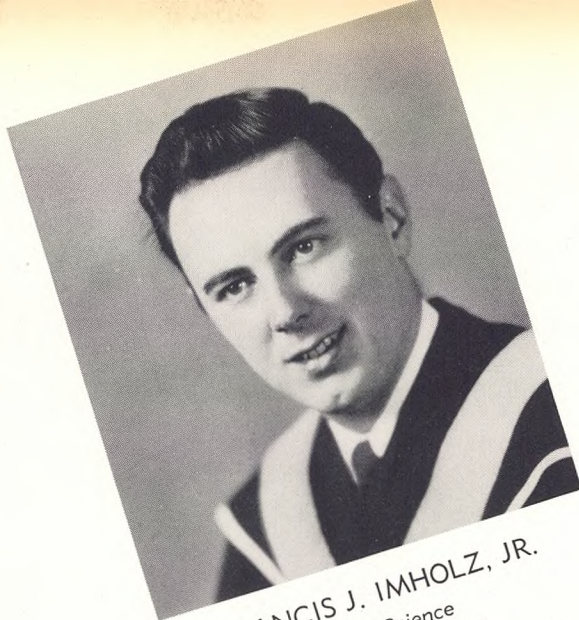




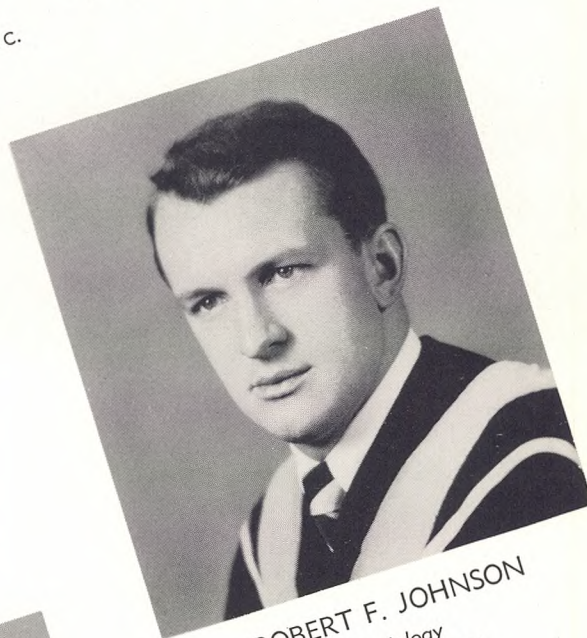
Department further helps the student in his other studies by enabling him to read books written in languages other than English.
