

Men's Baseball

SFC baseball team stands at 15-16 overall and 11-7 in the Northeast Conference. The key to the Terriers' success has been the team's balance. Eight players are currently batting above .300 mark, despite the fact that five of them started in only half of the team's games, showing that they can maintain a top level and contribute when called upon.

Senior Jason Iorio has been a consistent performer at the top of the Terrier batting order this season, and currently is hitting .382 with 19 runs scored, nine extra-base hits, and 16 runs batted in. He also leads the Terriers with 11 stolen bases.

Senior Matt Bailey has anchored the Terrier pitching staff, and sports a 6-1 record on the year so far. He, along with juniors Anthony Esposito and Christian Malave, carry the bulk of the pitching load for the Terriers and have kept the Terriers in playoff contention.

Women's Softball

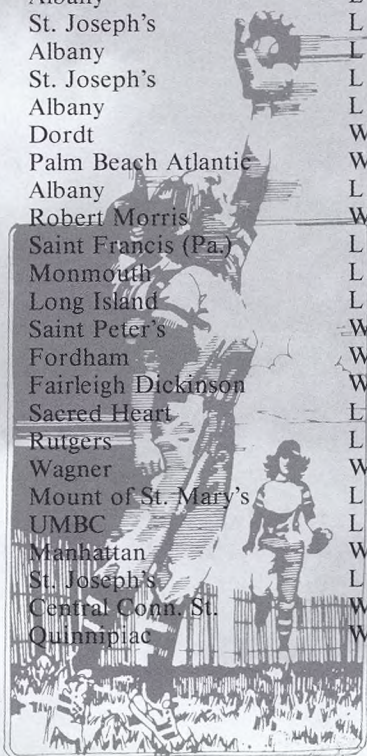
The St. Francis College softball team sports a 15-25 record and has already won more games in a season than any Terrier softball team in the last decade. The Terriers finished their Northeast Conference season with a 9-13 record, a marked improvement over last season's performance.

During the first weekend of conference play, the Terriers defeated both Robert Morris University and Saint Francis University of Pennsylvania, teams they had not defeated in the last ten years. The Terriers also swept a non-conference doubleheader from Fordham University for the first time in school history.

Junior Alex Richardson has been a standout player all season. She has broken her own school record with nine home runs thus far, and is batting .390 with 30 runs batted in. She is also the owner of a 5-10 record as a pitcher, and has struck out 72 batters.

Senior Samantha Griffin has risen to the level of the elite pitchers in the Northeast Conference. Griffin is currently 8-8 with a 1.73 earned run average, which is the lowest ERA for a Terrier pitcher since 1993. Four of her eight victories have come via the shutout, a pair of 1-0 wins.
